

GOOD WILL FARM FAMILY SERVICES PROGRAM

Part-time Family Services Intensive Caseworker: 20 hours per week

The Family Services Program is an in-home, family focused program designed to identify, arrange and/or provide a wide range of services for youth and their families.

The Intensive Caseworker **will assist the family** in:

- Identifying family strengths and issues
- Setting individual and family goals
- Planning strategies and implementing activities to accomplish goals

The Intensive Caseworker **will provide** the following in-home services:

- Youth and family education
- Support and review of goal progress
- Life and home management skills
- Crisis intervention

The Intensive Caseworker will also assist in the following mentoring, advocacy, and outreach services:

- Attendance with youth/parent(s) at school, court, DHS offices, and/or other agencies, as appropriate
- Identify and coordinate community resources to benefit family and youth
- Youth/family job development and search activity
- One-on-one mentoring with youth

Services will accommodate family schedules as much as possible. The typical number of home visits by the Intensive Caseworker is three per week the first two weeks, two per week the next ten weeks and weekly thereafter. More visits may be required to assist families accomplish goals. Average length of the program is between six and nine months.
